

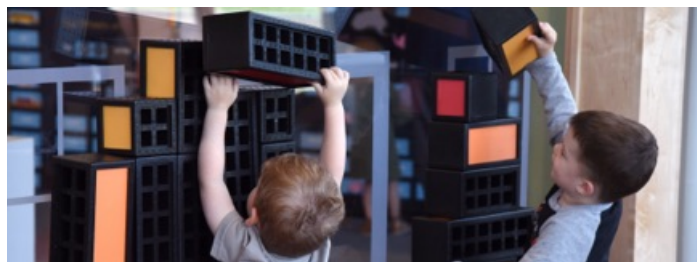
BUILDING BUDDIES

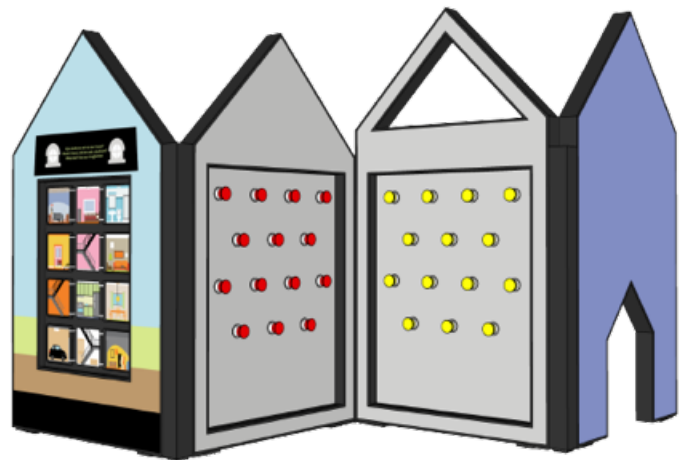
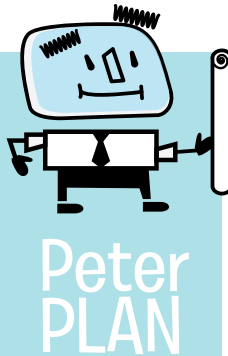
Time to get creative! Reorganize Peter's house by choosing the location of the different rooms and stairs to get there.

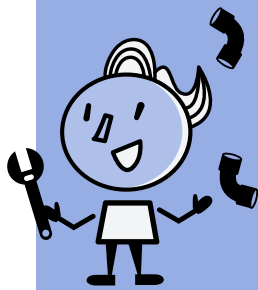

PIPA'S HOUSE

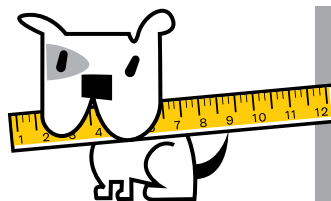
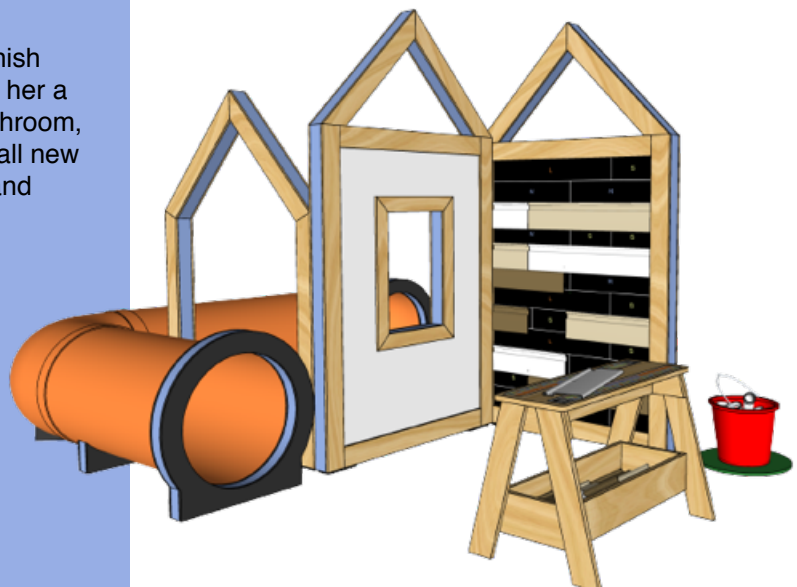
